Dear Friends,

For the last 90 years, Center For Family Services has remained an innovative organization dedicated to providing high quality services to at-risk, vulnerable children and families in Camden City and throughout the Southern Region of New Jersey. Our primary goal has always been to change lives and create bright futures for those who are disadvantaged and facing overwhelming obstacles. A glimpse into this year's annual report provides a snapshot of the breadth and depth of our prevention, intervention, and education services and programs designed to achieve this goal.

Throughout our 90 year history, CFS has worked to ensure that our services improve, change, and grow to meet the changing needs of the people and communities we serve. Our more than 50 programs exist to provide a continuum of services to meet our mission to support and empower individuals, families, and communities to achieve a better life through vision, hope, and strength. The services we deliver aim to:

- Shape children's futures by providing opportunities for safety, support, and success
- Strengthen families and help them stay together and become self-sufficient
- Build families for children who have nowhere else to turn

Headquartered in Camden City, we see the consequences of children and families not having the support, education, and resources they need to break the cycle of poverty and the distress they face each day. We have had a positive impact on thousands of children and families in southern New Jersey each year. We have steadily increased the number of evidence-based and model programs that enable us to demonstrate the outcomes of our programs and identify areas we need to improve. But, we must do more.

As we expand and improve our services throughout the Southern Region, we are also placing a special emphasis on creating a new model for change in Camden City, starting in our own neighborhood. This initiative represents a change in focus, a shift in how we target and deliver not only our own programs and services, but how we will lead a large

collaborative effort with anchor institutions, other service providers, businesses, and residents to invest in the children and families in Camden comprehensively and long term. This systematic approach challenges us to address the root causes of the issues that affect our community and make a difference not just one child, one family at a time – but for an entire neighborhood, fundamentally changing the community. This collaborative effort will change the outcomes for children in Camden. As we strive to achieve positive and lasting results, demonstrate positive outcomes, and ensure accountability in all that we do at CFS, the Promise Neighborhood raises our own ambitions and those of the children and families we serve.

We believe that the development of our children and the stabilization and strengthening of families is essential to building the leaders of tomorrow and the safe, thriving communities that offer the opportunities for success every child deserves. Our accomplishments for the last 90 years can be attributed to building strong community partnerships, developing and enriching cutting edge programs, expanding our base of supporters, and strengthening the skills and talents of our professional and compassionate staff.

We will build on our knowledge, experience, and success to achieve our ambitious goals by recognizing that we must always find ways to improve and by continuing to empower people with information, support, and resources. Center For Family Services offers a wide range of services dedicated to improving the lives of children, youth, and families. Each of our more than 50 programs is designed to ensure that people are able to reach their full potential at every stage of life, from birth to old age. Our service areas include:

Child, Adolescent, and Family Services

Strengthening the capacity of young people and at risk families to navigate difficult times and make positive choices. Our staff teaches critical parenting skills, increased problem solving abilities, decrease high-risk behaviors, and offer counseling and support services. Our staff strengthened over 4757 children and families last year with these services.

Safe and Supportive Housing

Providing shelter, security, and support for children who are homeless, runaways, neglected or abused, moms who are homeless with their children, and women escaping domestic violence. Our continuum gives youth and adults the stable foundation they need to become self-sufficient through temporary shelters, residential treatment centers, transitional living apartments, and the development of permanent affordable housing. Our facilities were a safe, secure home for 671 young people last year alone.

Substance Abuse Treatment

Offering assessment, treatment, education, and support. This is available for adolescents, adults, and families, including a specialized program for mothers working to overcome their addictions and maintain or regain custody of their children, as well as the only program in the state that provides addiction recovery and case management services for the deaf – by the deaf. Over 4042 people received treatment to overcome their addictions last year alone, and received over 52,192 hours of service.

Victim and Trauma Response

Responding to people of all ages who have been the victim of trauma, sexual or domestic violence. Staff provides 24 hour live hotline response; counseling; accompaniments to hospitals, law enforcement and courts; advocacy and intervention. These services impact the lives of more than 1438 victims and their families.

Counseling, Community, and School Based Services

Working with vulnerable people to connect them to the resources they need through statewide and local 24-hour hotlines. We provide individual, group, and family counseling, help low income seniors stay safely in their homes, and conduct child assault and bullying prevention programs in schools. Over 525 people received counseling services, and more than 59,840 people were helped through hotline responses, and assault prevention, and bullying workshops.

The Year in Review

Over **175,877** hours of service and days of shelter were provided last year to our local community. **58,679** calls were answered live by our 24 hour hotline services. **526** employees and more than **500** volunteers worked to make a difference in **53** programs designed to provide the best possible opportunity for people of all ages to live a better life. **11,425** people received comprehensive direct services and support.

A Fundamental, Sustainable Change

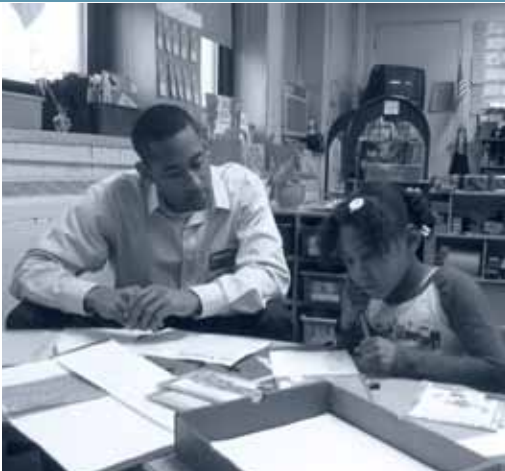
Our goal, in collaboration with Rowan University, Cooper University Hospital, the City of Camden, and a team of organizations and community representatives, is to build a Promise Neighborhood in the Cooper Lanning section of Camden City. Using the nationally recognized Harlem Children’s Zone model, our team is developing a long term strategic plan to transform an entire neighborhood by creating a comprehensive cradle through college pipeline of evidence and outcomes based programs. This model will be expanded through a block by block approach with a goal of building the program to full scale over time.

The Harlem Children’s Zone began with founder Geoffrey Canada asking himself several critical questions that all poverty stricken communities must consider, including “What would it take to change the lives of poor children not one by one, through heroic interventions and occasional miracles, but in a programmatic, standardized way that could be applied broadly and replicated nationwide?” His answer to truly making a fundamental, sustainable change was “to transform every aspect of the environment that poor children are growing up in; to change the way their families raise them, and the way their schools teach them as well as the character of the neighborhood that surrounds them.” Our goal is to achieve this through the creation of the Cooper Lanning Promise Neighborhood in Camden City.

As Geoffrey Canada did in Harlem, we realize that we must address generational poverty and its adverse outcomes in a dramatically different way in order to effect change on a scale that will break that cycle of poverty not just for a few people, but for entire neighborhoods, and ultimately all of Camden City. Camden City has a history of serious problems which continue to plague the city. The negative picture too frequently portrayed in the

Center For Family Services has a long history of providing services that change the lives of individuals, children, and families throughout the southern New Jersey community. We have supported children and teens through overwhelming challenges so that they can have a second chance at a better future, stabilized families through parenting and life skills programs, and helped individuals of all ages overcome serious life challenges.

Our work has focused on the individual needs of each of our clients and we have demonstrated success through our 90 years of service and more than 50 programs. Now, we are taking our work to the next level and leading a major initiative to break the cycle of generational poverty in Camden through a results-focused neighborhood approach.

media is one of problems which continue to plague the city. The negative picture too frequently portrayed in the media is one of a city filled only with violence, drugs, broken families, and homelessness. This portrayal is far from accurate. There are children and good, caring families living in Camden – each of whom deserve a chance for success and an opportunity for a better life. But the poverty they struggle with, the violence they are living around, the lack of positive educational outcomes, and decreased job opportunities overwhelms and prevents the majority of these children and families from getting the skills, training, and support they need to succeed.

CFS has been headquartered in Camden since its inception in 1920 and we have worked with the community to overcome some of these challenges for children and families. For nearly a century, we have maintained our commitment to improving the lives of at-risk children and individuals of all ages. Now, we are taking the next step, along with other community stakeholders, service organizations, and residents, to transform every aspect of the environment for a child. By providing a pipeline of continuous and comprehensive services that change the way children are raised, the way they learn, and the neighborhood that surrounds them, the focus is proactive instead of reactive.

All successful, sustainable projects require significant work, commitment, and investment, and Camden’s Promise Neighborhood is no exception. There is no investment more worthwhile than one that will change the educational, employment, and socioeconomic outcomes for children being born in Camden today. Changing the outcomes for children in Camden City in a systemic, tangible, and accountable way has yet to be attempted at this level. We must take a different

approach to expect different outcomes. Our access to the Harlem Children’s Zone and the significant commitment from community partners provides the blue print and the capacity to develop and implement an effective initiative. Working together, we can make Camden’s first Promise Neighborhood a pipeline of success for kids and prevent another generation from becoming the horrifying statistics by which the nation now recognizes Camden City.

Cultivating a Generation of Service



We realize that making a commitment to our community must go beyond the programs and services we provide to vulnerable children and families. We want to develop the next generation of leaders who have a passion for helping others. Center For Family Services' new program – Quixote Quest – is a unique community based service learning program that educates teens about community needs, listens to their thoughts about their volunteer service, and celebrates their efforts to build lasting positive relationships.

Triggered by the events of 9/11, Quixote Quest was developed in 2002 to marshal the talents and energy of teens in South Jersey. Quixote Quest continued to grow, and in 2010 joined Center For Family Services with a shared goal to positively develop volunteer teens and to assist them in making a meaningful impact in the community. Now, as part of CFS, Quixote Quest continues to inspire more and more high school teens to ask themselves, “What more can I do?”

Quixote Quest is a youth volunteer movement which engages and supports New Jersey teens in consistent and meaningful community service. Teens make a commitment in September to serve at least two hours a week for one year at a project that holds meaning for them, and more importantly holds meaning to those being impacted by their pledge. “The goal is for students to make tangible differences in the life of a person or project through service” says Frank McGough, program director of Quixote Quest.

Teens in the program choose service opportunities that include homework help for children with disabilities, legacy projects, spending time with animals living in a local shelter, and organizing drives to gather items for families in need. Through clubs in Camden, Gloucester, Burlington, Mercer, and Middlesex Counties, Quixote Quest has over 100 teens in action completing their weekly service and participating in monthly group service projects.

Quixote Quest is an organization open to all high school teens willing to make a difference. It positions them so they can perform direct service in a place where they have a chance to make real change. Quixote Quest is one of few community-based Service Learning programs in the country and is the first in the state. The weekly service and two monthly meetings make it the highest level of volunteer commitment a young person can make in high school. QQ recognizes the power of youth volunteerism in changing the lives of those in need.

The intent of Quixote Quest is to provide each member with the richest possible experience, where they feel that their major commitment of time has made a difference, and what they do is important to the community. This is the key to QQ achieving its mission “to engage youth in consistent and meaningful volunteer service...encouraging a lifelong commitment to voluntarism and philanthropy.”



After seeing the real impact these teens have on our communities, the Comcast Foundation made a \$75,000 commitment to sustain and grow Center For Family Services' Quixote Quest Program over the next three years. Comcast shares our mission of promoting community service and building tomorrow's leaders.

Quixote Quest is building the next generation of altruistic members of society. The students are actively engaged in exploring the value of reinvesting in their community, and will undoubtedly shape the future of philanthropy, volunteerism, and the nonprofit sector.

Encouraging Independent Families

Depressed. Worried. Angry. Confused. These are the words Bahiyyah Megginson used to describe herself before Center For Family Services Family CONNECT program came into her life. “I not only lost my job but also my self value,” said Bahiyyah, “I was making unwise decisions and going down the wrong path.”

Every client that steps into Center For Family Services has different needs and challenges, but our effort to help them become independent, self-sustaining individuals is constant. To ensure we deliver the best possible practices and methods to help the South Jersey community, CFS continues to invest in evidence-based programs and strives to establish comprehensive ways to track and measure outcomes with the goal of helping to strengthen the individual and family unit.

At CFS, we recognize the varying needs among our clients and in order to effectively provide the tools to impact lives in a positive way, we must continually refine our services to best meet changing needs. Outcomes and evidence based models give us the necessary feedback to help ensure that those who are most in need are served effectively and funds are used responsibly.

Like many clients who come to CFS, Bahiyyah needed a job to get back on her feet but employment was not the only answer to her problems. She needed guidance to understand her bills and finances, a program that would increase her self-esteem and confidence, someone to help her work through the trauma she suffered as a teen, and resources that would help her children succeed. What Bahiyyah needed was Family CONNECT.

Through funding from the New Jersey Department of Children and Families, and partnerships with Weisman Children’s Rehabilitation Hospital & Center, Camden City, Cooper Hospital, and Camden City Schools, Center For Family Services is providing the Family CONNECT program, an evidence-based model adapted with permission from University of Maryland’s School of Social Work.

Through Family CONNECT, a 12 week, in-home supportive service, counselors help parents get their lives back in order by connecting them to resources within CFS and the community. Parents are taught how to care and discipline their children appropriately,

develop strong relationships with children’s teachers and doctors, search for employment or seek higher education, find safe and affordable housing, understand and manage bills and finances, and treat depression, anger, and family issues through individual and family counseling. The outcomes that are tied to this program include:

- Increasing child safety & adequate supervision
- Preventing incidents of child abuse & neglect
- Improving living conditions in household
- Reducing rates of truancy



“This program has changed my spirit”, said Bahiyyah at Family CONNECT’s Advisory Board Meeting after completing the program. “When Family CONNECT first came to me I was depressed and didn’t care about myself. Now, I am a new person since my case worker, Valerie, brought resources into my life. It was through the collaboration of the counselors at Family CONNECT and throughout Center For Family Services that my spirit within myself and within my home has changed for the better.”

Happy. Hopeful. Goal-oriented. Valued. “I am getting my house in order so I can be complete for myself and for my family,” says the new and improved Bahiyyah Megginson.

Operation Backpack



Many families in our community are struggling to provide shelter and food for their children and the daily stress of making choices between necessities can be overwhelming. Back to school time can be especially stressful for disadvantaged families and exceptionally difficult for children who do not have the supplies they need on the first day.

Operation Backpack is a community wide effort that began in 2004 as a call to action for individuals, companies, and organizations to positively impact the life of a child on the first day of school. The drive has grown to provide support to more than 2000 children each year. All backpacks and school supplies are distributed to needy children in our community with the goal of providing every student with the necessary tools to be successful and achieve their fullest potential.

By supporting Operation Backpack and fulfilling the fundamental need of school supplies, we are not only preparing a child for the opportunity for a successful start to the school year, but also increasing the child's confidence and desire to do well. More importantly, we send the message that we believe the children in our community can succeed in school.



Denim Day

Center For Family Services newest endeavor reaches out to more than just the children and families served by our programs. It focuses on an epidemic whose victims include men, women, boys, and girls. The Denim Day campaign was launched by CFS in 2010 as an answer to the staggering number of sexual assaults throughout the country.

The statistics are daunting: 1 in 5 female college students and 1 in 6 American women will be sexually assaulted. Many victims feel ashamed or embarrassed leaving many cases unreported and victims searching for answers and facing depression. Sexual violence has become so prevalent that the Center for Disease Control considers it one of the fastest growing epidemics in the nation.

Last year, the State of New Jersey officially adopted April 28th as Denim Day, a call to action for people to come together for the health and safety of everyone in the community. While Denim Day is fresh to New Jersey, its origin dates back nearly 12 years. In 1998, an Italian court case sparked international outrage when judges did not convict a rapist because the victim wore jeans. The judges ruled that because the victim was wearing tight jeans, she must have helped her attacker remove them, implying consent.

The Center For Family Services' Services Empowering the Rights of Victims (SERV) program has been providing services for victims and survivors of sexual and domestic violence for over a decade. Center For Family Services was proud to join the national Denim Day movement last year to raise awareness about how to end sexual violence through prevention and education and how to get help if you have been a victim.

In the inaugural year, CFS' Denim Day campaign united more than 1200 community members from businesses, organizations, schools, and universities across southern New Jersey, wearing denim as a visible sign of support to prevent sexual violence in our community and help victims become survivors.

Holiday Gift Project

With over 1500 children and teens in our care through shelters, group homes, and supportive programs, Center For Family Services relies on the generosity of the community during the holiday season. The holidays can be an especially difficult time for children and families experiencing poverty and homelessness. We are dedicated to providing the support that creates a home-like experience for children at each of our residential locations...we are family for them.

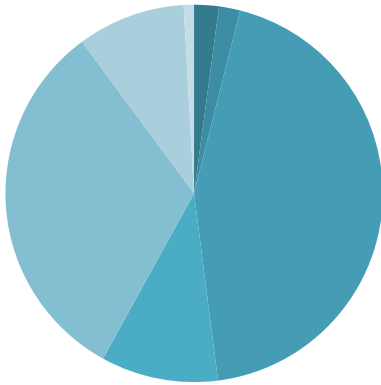

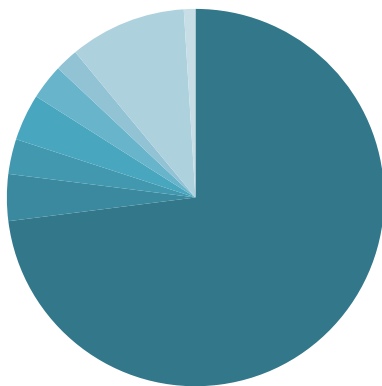
