The program provides a safe-haven to come together, share experiences, and learn new ways to cope with grief and the loss of a loved one. This program is provided at no cost to participants and is presented by the Camden County Board of Freeholders' Addiction Awareness Taskforce and Office of Mental Health and Addiction.
