# **Appendix B**

#### **Definitions**

- Physical Aggression behavior causing or threatening physical harm towards others.
  This can include but is not limited to hitting, kicking, pushing, or throwing items at someone.
- o **Verbal Aggression** is a verbal assault on another person. This can include but is not limited to cursing, yelling, and screaming.
- Sexual Boundary breaking sexual boundaries with another. This includes touching, kissing, sexual comments or innuendos, and receiving sexual emails or text messages.
- o **Sexual Abuse** Unwanted sexual contact by one person on another.
- o **Theft by consumer** The taking or removing of personal property by a consumer with intent to deprive the rightful owner.
- o **Theft of consumer property** Taking of property belonging to a person served without permission
- o **Threat (verbal or emotional) made by consumer** A statement made by a consumer with the intent to cause harm to another.
- o **Threat (verbal or emotional) made to consumer** A statement made to a consumer with intent to cause harm to the youth.
- O **Physical Abuse** Use of physical force to cause physical harm or pain by a person who is in a position of authority over another, such as a counselor causing physical harm to a youth or a teacher causing physical harm to a student.
- O **Verbal or Emotional Abuse** Use of words to attack or injure an individual by a person who is in a position of authority over another, such as a counselor causing emotional harm to a youth or a teacher causing emotional harm to a student.
- o **Smoking** Use or inhalation of tobacco such as cigarettes, cigars, or a pipe. This includes the use of electronic cigarettes. (for example, for a youth in our residential programs or if a consumer is smoking inside a smoke-free building)
- o **Fire Setting** creating or using a flame for any reason other than to prepare a meal.
