September 16th–23rd is Bisexual Awareness Week, Culminating in Celebrate Bisexuality Day on September 23rd!

From the lens of overall well-being and healthcare, **“Bi+ people experience disproportionately high rates of mental health challenges, substance use disorders, chronic stress, and healthcare avoidance**, driven by persistent biphobia, erasure, and a lack of provider understanding.

Many bi+ individuals report being **misunderstood, dismissed, or forced to self-advocate** in healthcare systems that were not designed with their experiences in mind. These barriers are compounded for bi+ people who are neurodivergent, disabled, trans, people of color, or otherwise multiply marginalized.”

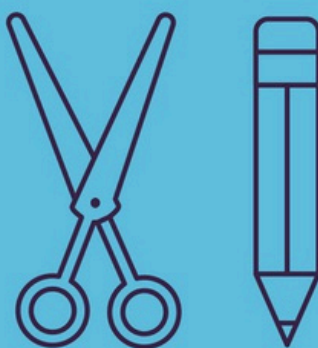

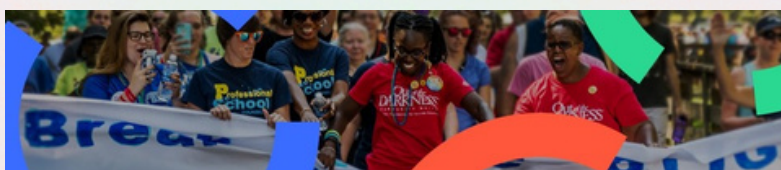
